2020 Tournaments

The Executive Board held a meeting with the use of ZOOM this Saturday, May 2, 2020. After much discussion and due to our difficult and uncertain times we have decided on the following changes to this year's golf season.

1. Due to the shortened season and restricted number of players per tournament, we are canceling all MAJORS. These courses will run a regular tournament in its place.
2. Also, due to these restrictions beyond our control, we will not award points and balls after each tournament.
3. Courses may not all provide the scorecards and it will be the responsibility of the tournament chair and /or club rep to provide two scorecards per player.
4. Scorecards will be dropped into large manila envelopes by division after completing play.
5. All results will be posted on WCWGA Facebook page.
6. Each player must post her score THAT DAY as per World Handicap System guidelines.
7. The host Representative will calculate the players' handicaps for the course, on the 5th day after the closing date of the tournament.
8. If courses limit the number of players all Division Chairs will not be cut. The Wait List procedures will be followed for all others.
9. All ball money will go to the Worcester County Food Bank.
